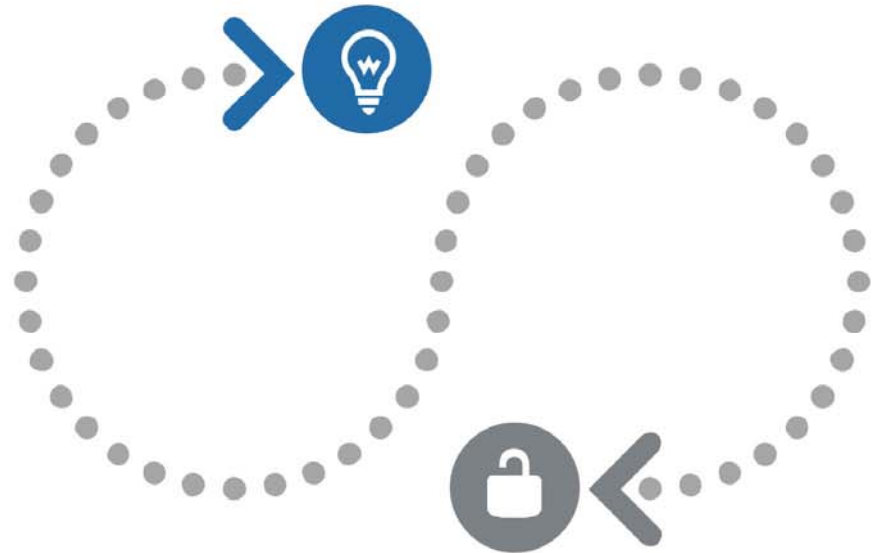
PURPOSE AND CHALLENGE
